12:02 – Vote to approve the proposed 2019 budget passed with a clear majority with no discussion.

12:03 – Joe began discussion of the capital campaign by reading Rachel Maxwell's recommendation. Chuck Harris provided a brief overview of the campaign thus far. Attendee discussions revolved around the potential cost, parking issues, and the needs of congregants from Pullman.

12:41 – Vote to hold a capital campaign to expand our facilities at our current location passed with 65 "ayes" and 5 "nays," (93% approval).
