

Fulfilling Our Dream of Radical Welcome



You are invited to join in as we embark on a mission to build a major addition on our church, with the dream of making this a place of radical welcoming for members of our church & community!

Our Stewardship Kick-Off & Celebration will be at the UUCP Friday, November 15, 6-8pm

After considerable discussion and polling over the last several years, our congregation voted to proceed with a plan to remove the Yellow House, keep our beloved church building, and add a major addition to it (as shown above), expanding both RE space and sanctuary. Details can be seen on our website, Facebook page, and on posters at church. The cost for this plan is estimated at \$1.7 million. The Feasibility Study done in September 2019 indicated that our church should be able to raise this much - or more!

The Basic Building Plans

- A spacious three-story addition with new staff offices
- Universal access to all facilities, including an elevator
- Expanded and improved RE classrooms
- Increased space and seating in the sanctuary
- A commercial kitchen & expanded Fellowship Hall
- Enhanced facilities to host community events
- Eight additional parking spaces, including ADA spaces

Possible Supplementary Alternatives

- Solar panels on roof of the addition
- A balcony with additional sanctuary seating
- Replace the large window in foyer
- Replace wood exterior siding
- Finish third floor, for additional meeting space

What's Next? Stewards from our congregation will be contacting potential donors - all UUCP members, households that have made annual pledges, as well as other individuals and organizations in our community - over the next several months, to seek their support for this project.
